The City Of Nawabs

Lucknow is the capital of Uttar Pradesh, India, renowned for its rich cultural heritage, historical architecture from the Nawabi era, and unique cuisine. Known as the "City of Nawabs," it is a significant center for art, music, and poetry.

Culture & Heritage




